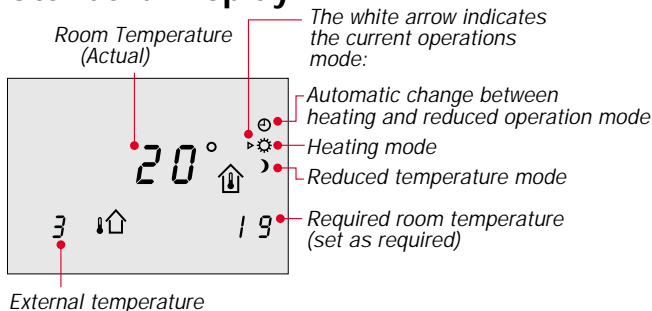

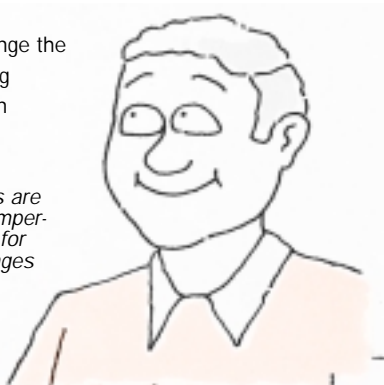
Standard Display

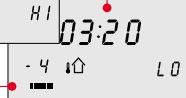

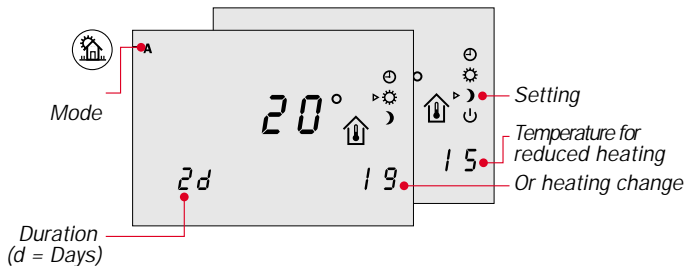
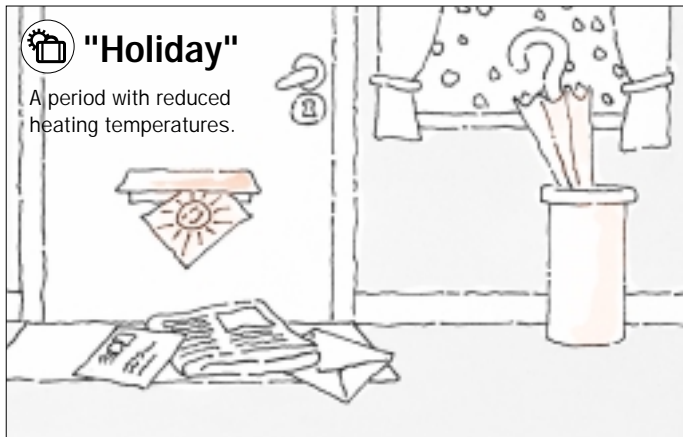
Press once for every day with normal operation or....

Press once for each hour of reduced heating

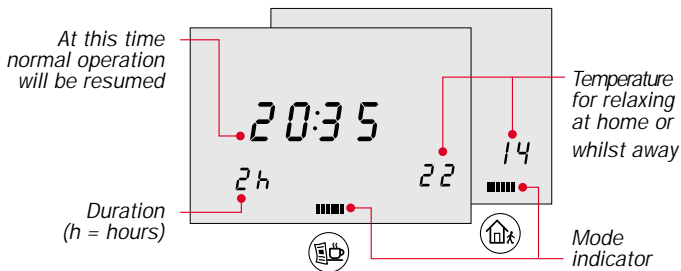

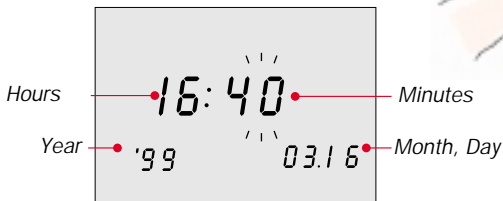




Setting the clock
